LITERACY

Phonics

Please complete pages 38 and 39 of Sounds Make Words textbook These pages introduce the tricky sound "oa". We call them tricky sounds as the we can't sound them out "o" and "a" as when these two sounds are together they make a very different sound " oa " that we hear in the word "goat".

Writing

Please complete All Write now pages 57,58,61 which revise letter formation. Please make sure your child is holding their pencil correctly using the tripod grip and forming letters as shown. Continue writing "Today is..." but encourage your child to write a little about their family or their pet once or twice this week.

Oral Language

You may like to read the story story Rumble In The Jungle which is available on Youtube. Discuss the differences between farm animals and wild animals. Show the children illustrations of various wild animals, name them and describe them. Your child may also have fun imitating sounds made by wild animals from the story to link in with this week's SESE

SESE

Please complete page 31 of Explorers textbook

Help your child to recognise and identify a variety of sounds in the environment when you take them outside for a walk. Try to allow them to notice the difference between high and low sounds, loud and soft sounds.

If you would like, you could try to make an instrument with your child. For example, you could fill an empty bottle with rice or stones to make a shaker, you could stretch elastic bands around a tissue box to make a guitar or make a drum using an old tin box . We understand that due to present circumstances this may not be possible for you to do. This is totally understandable and we do not want to put pressure on anyone to do this optional activity.
