Please revise writing the letters c,k,e,h,r,m this week, on lined paper if you can. Please make sure your child is holding their pencil correctly and is making the letters properly.

Continue with free writing "I like..." and encourage your child to write a little about a visit to the park or about a rainbow once or twice this week Free writing -the children can draw a picture of anything they like and write about it. Don't worry about spellings or handwriting!!
