### **LITERACY**

#### **Phonics**

Please complete pages 42 and 43 of Sounds Make Words textbook. These pages introduce the tricky sound "ee". This is the sound that we hear in words such as bee, see, sheep, feet, tree

Please complete pages 45 and 46 of Sounds Make Words textbook. These pages introduce the tricky sound "or". This is the sound we hear in words such as short, fork, torch, corn, storm.

Please revise words/items that begin with the sounds c,k,e,h,r,m. Please show these letters to your child and ask him/her to tell you what sounds they make. Look up **Jolly phonic sounds on youtube** to help you with the sounds

#### **Writing**

Please complete All Write now pages 32 and 33. Continue with the revision pages at the back of the book. We are on page 60 this week.

Please revise writing the letters c,k,e,h,r,m this week, on lined paper if you can. Please make sure your child is holding their pencil correctly and is making the letters properly.

Continue with free writing "I like..." and encourage your child to write a little about a visit to the park or about a rainbow once or twice this week

Free writing -the children can draw a picture of anything they like and write about it. Don't worry about spellings or handwriting!!

#### **Reading**

The children have now completed learning their **30 Tricky Words** for Junior Infants. Please continue to revise these words. Encourage your child to create sentences with these words in them so as to ensure understanding. If you don't have them, please let us know and we will send you a copy.
