



# How to Make a Daisy Chain

Daisy chains are a lovely thing to do on a sunny day. Use these step-by-step instructions to make a daisy chain.



## You Will Need

- · A few daisies with their stems.
- 1. Hold a daisy in your hand.
- Use your thumbnail to make a small slit in the stem of the daisy.
- Pick up another daisy and thread that stem through the slit.
- Then make a slit in the new daisy stem you have just threaded through.
- Thread another daisy through that one and carry on. You will soon have a lovely chain of threaded daisies.
