Work for Senior Infants 1/02/2021 to 05/02/2021

Dear Parents,

It's hard to believe that we have already reached the fourth week of distance learning and that February has arrived. Thanks to you all for your engagement with the work so far. This month, we will explore the Spring theme and there will be a focus on *signs of Spring and new life*. When you are out and about for walks, ask your child to pay attention to the signs of Spring in nature. For the coming week, we suggest that children complete the following tasks:

English and literacy

All Write Now: Pages 34, 35 & 57

Tricky Words: Please revise these tricky words:

any, many, more, before, other, were, because, want, saw, These are sight words that the children must remember.

Writing Copy: Copy news from Seesaw into copy. This week, write about 'My favourite pet'. If you don't have a pet at home, you can write about your favourite pet or a trip to a pet farm. Remember to write neatly and to draw some nice pictures also.

Record a video based on the theme of *Pets***:** We would also like to provide children with the opportunity to record a short video about their pet or favourite pet which can be shared with the class. **This is only a suggestion and children are not obliged to engage in this activity.** We know that the children miss their friends, so if your child would like to share a video with their peers on Seesaw, please send the video with a comment to let the teacher know that you are happy for your video to be shared. We will only share your video if we get this permission.
