Well done on all your great work before the mid-term break! We will continue to focus on the theme of Spring again this week and we suggest that children complete the following tasks:

# **English and literacy**

**All Write Now:** Pages 40, 41, 42, 43

**Tricky Words:** Please revise the final 10 tricky words for Senior Infants: could, would, should, right, two, four, goes, does, made, their

These are sight words that the children must remember.

**Writing Copy:** Copy news from Seesaw into copy. This week, write about *'The lamb'* and for free writing tell us about your mid-term break. Remember to write neatly and to draw some nice pictures also.

Record a video based on the theme of *Your Favourite Toy*: We would also like to provide children with the opportunity to record a short video about your favourite toy which can be shared with the class. This is only a suggestion and children are not obliged to engage in this activity. We know that the children miss their friends, so if your child would like to share a video with their peers on Seesaw, please send the video with a comment to let the teacher know that you are happy for your video to be shared. We will only share your video if we get this permission.
