English and literacy

All Write Now : Pages 37, 38 & 39

Tricky Words: Please revise all tricky words 1-50: *I, the, he, she, me, we, be, was, to, do are, all, you, you, come, some, said, here, there, they go, no, so, my, one, by, like, have, live, give only, old, little, down, what, when, why, where, who, which any, many, more, before, other, were, because, want, saw, put could, should, would, right, two, four, goes, does, made, their* These are sight words that the children must remember.

Writing Copy: Copy news from Seesaw into copy. This week, write about *'My family'*. Remember to write neatly and to draw some nice pictures also.
